Dear Ms. Wallström,

In accordance with the applicable procedure, the Dutch House of Representatives of the States General has assessed the proposals mentioned above for Regulations of the European Parliament and the Council on the basis of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality. As such, use was made of Article 5 of the EC Treaty and Protocol 30 of the Treaty of Amsterdam on the application of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality.

This letter is intended to inform you about the position of the House of Representatives of the States General. Copies of this letter were sent to the European Parliament, the Council, COSAC and the Dutch Government.

The States General did not find any problems with respect to the legal basis, subsidiarity or proportionality. However, the House would be grateful to receive from the European Commission a further justification of the chosen legal basis (article 95), in relation to the competence of the European Supervisory Authorities to take binding decisions in certain cases.
