## **OPINION**

## of the ROMANIAN SENATE, on the

Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council establishing technical requirements for credit transfers and direct debits in euros and amending Regulation no. 924/2009 – COM (2010) 775 final

The Senate of Romania has checked the compliance with the subsidiarity and proportionality principles of the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council establishing technical requirements for credit transfers and direct debits in euros and amending Regulation no. 924/2009 – COM (2010) 775 final, according to the provisions of the Treaty of Lisbon (protocol no.2).

Taking into account the report of our permanent Committee for finances, budget and bank activities, **the Plenum of the Senate**, during its session of the 28-th of Febryary 2011, has found that the mentioned proposal, elaborated according to Article 5 of the Treaty of the European Union, **is compliant with the subsidiarity and proportionality principles**, taking into consideration that the target of good functionning of credits transfers and direct debits in euros cannot be raisonable reached by the Member States by themselves and doesnot exceed what is necessary to achieve this objective.
