The Senate

I.

1. Holds the opinion

that the adoption of the package as a comprehensive set of rules to combat money laundering and financing of terrorism is much needed, especially due to the institutional fragmentation and poor coordination at the EU level;

2. Also holds the opinion

that the submitted proposals of regulations and directives are in many respects problematic or incomplete;

3. Supports

the position of the Government of the Czech Republic, which calls for the completion, specification and clarification of some points of these proposals;

4. Draws attention especially to

- the inadequacy to burden the liable entities with mandatory fee obligation in order to secure funding of the newly established Authority for Anti-Money Laundering and Countering the Financing of Terrorism;
- the possible negative impact not only on the national budgets of individual Member States but also on the administrative burden on both the public sector and private entities;
- the possibility that the proposed changes might lead to an overall reduction in the effectiveness of the system of combating money laundering and financing of terrorism in the Czech Republic as well as at the level of the European Union;

II.

1. Requests the Government

to inform the Senate by 30 June 2022 about the way this Resolution was taken into account and about further proceedings of negotiations;
