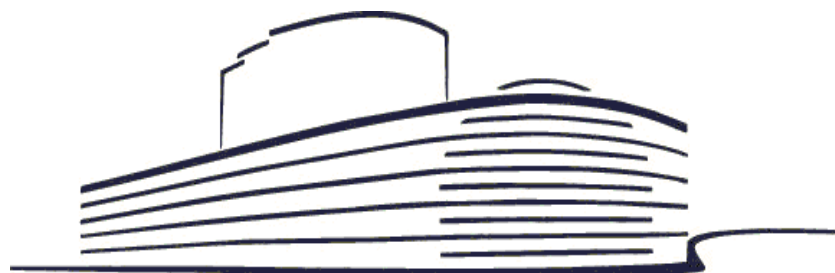

## **7. Election of Quaestors of Parliament (first and second ballots)**

The President announced that he had received the following nominations for the election of Quaestors:

Catherine Bearder, Dennis de Jong, Karol Karski, Andrey Kovatchev, Bogusław Liberadzki and Elisabeth Morin-Chartier

As the number of candidates exceeded the number of seats to be filled, a secret ballot would be held under Rule 15(1) by electronic vote.

Under Rule 18, second paragraph, the same rules would apply to this election as to the election of vice-presidents.

The vote was held.

*First ballot*

The President read out the results of the ballot:

- Members voting: 696
- Blank or void: 19
- Votes cast: 677
- Absolute majority: 339

Votes obtained were as follows, in descending order:

- Elisabeth Morin-Chartier: 452 votes
- Bogusław Liberadzki: 443 votes
- Catherine Bearder: 425 votes
- Andrey Kovatchev: 420 votes
- Karol Karski: 288 votes
- Dennis de Jong: 152 votes

*(The list of Members voting is annexed to these Minutes.)*

Elisabeth Morin-Chartier, Bogusław Liberadzki, Catherine Bearder and Andrey Kovatchev had each obtained an absolute majority of the votes cast and were declared Quaestors of Parliament.

As one seat remained to be filled, a second ballot was required. The President noted that the nominations would be the same as for the first ballot..

The vote was held.

*Second ballot*

The President read out the results of the second ballot:

- Members voting: 660
- Blank or void: 52
- Votes cast: 608
- Absolute majority: 305

Votes obtained were as follows, in descending order::

Karol Karski: 347 votes

Dennis de Jong: 261 votes
