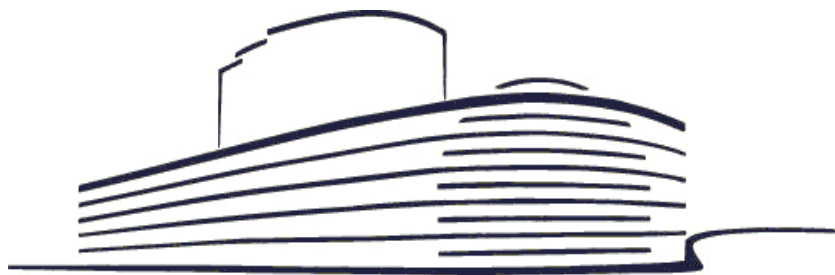

### **4. Composition of Parliament**

The Polish national authorities had informed Parliament of the election of Andrzej Duda as President of the Republic of Poland.

This function being, pursuant to Article 7, paragraph 3 of the Act of 20 September 1976 concerning the election of the representatives of the European Parliament by direct universal suffrage, incompatible with occupying a post as a Member of the European Parliament, Parliament establishes the vacancy of the seat, on the basis of Rule 4(4) of its Rules of Procedure, with effect from 26 May 2015 and informs the Member State concerned accordingly.

### **5. Composition of committees and delegations**

The President had received the following requests for appointments from the EFDD and PPE Groups:

ECON Committee: Diane James to replace Patrick O'Flynn

Delegation to the Euro-Latin American Parliamentary Assembly: Pablo Zalba Bidegain to replace Tom Vandenkendelaere.
