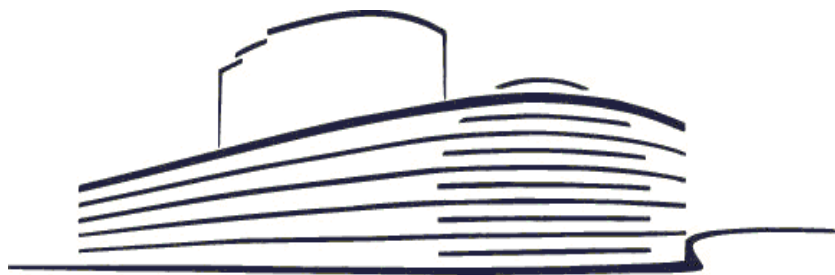

DECISION TO ENTER INTO INTERINSTITUTIONAL NEGOTIATIONS

Approved
