


Citizens believe **EU's action in** insufficient




Citizens expect more from the EU


The fight against terrorism

Expectations vary greatly between Member States

- ☐ On **migration policy** (EU 74%), **34** percentage point difference between Cyprus (91%) and Austria/Denmark (57%)
- ☐ On **protection of external borders** (EU 71%), **39** percentage point difference between Portugal (87%) and Sweden (48%)
- ☐ On **energy supply and energy security** (EU 53%), **40** percentage point difference between Cyprus (75%) and Czech Republic (35%)
- ☐ On **agriculture** (EU 50%), **51** percentage point difference between Romania (74%) and Denmark (23%)
- ☐ On **equal treatment of men and women** (EU 55%), **51** percentage point difference between Sweden (79%) and Latvia (28%)
- ☐ On **economic policy** (EU 52%), **53** percentage point difference between Cyprus (80%) and Denmark (27%)






The fight against unemployment









Generally speaking, do you think that (OUR COUNTRY)'s membership of the EU is...?






Most Urgent Measures to Fight against Terrorism and Radicalisation

The respondents had to choose up to 4 measures:


- On measures to fight terrorism, they gave on average 3,3 answers (up to 3,7 answers in Sweden and Netherlands)














