



Please tell me to what extent you agree or disagree with each of the following statements: My voice counts in the EU *Answer: Total "Agree"* (%)



Please tell me to what extent you agree or disagree with each of the following statements: My voice counts in the EU *Answer: Total "Agree" (%)*







Answer: Total "positive" (%)





Answer: Total "positive" (%)









Would you personally like to see the European Parliament play a more important or less important role than it currently does? Answer: "More important" (%)



TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Population: Around 1000 respondents (15 years old +) per survey

Methodology: Face-to-face – Eurobarometer surveys carried out by Kantar Public

Margin of error: For this sample size the actual percentage would vary within

the following intervals:

Percentages observed	10% or 90%	20% or 80%	30% or 70%	40% or 60%	50%
Margin of error	+/- 1.9 points	+/- 2.5 points	+/- 2.7 points	+/- 3.0 points	+/- 3.1 points

Example: If a result is given in this document as 35%, the actual percentage across the whole population might vary between 32.3% and 37.7%.
