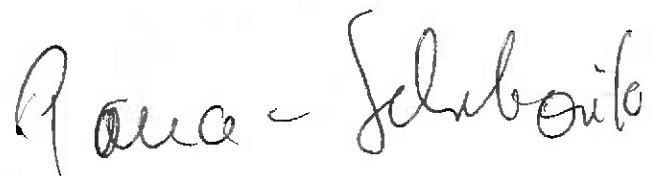
I am sure this hearing will prove to be interesting and fruitful. I hope to have soon other opportunities to meet you.
