# **Preparing for the Unitary Patent**

#### Preparations at technical level

Select Committee and Preparatory Committee

#### Preparations at political level

- Ratification of the UPC Agreement by the 25 Contracting Member States (min. 13 required)
- 12 Member States have deposited their instruments of ratification:
   i.e. AT, BE, BG, DK, FI, FR, IT, LU, MT, NL, PT, SE



# **Preparing for the Unitary Patent**

Our common target is to see the first unitary patent granted in 2017

"All participating Member States [should] start, or complete, their ratification of the UPC Agreement", Commissioner Bieńkowska, 20/2/17

Commission encourages <u>all</u> Member States to participate in enhanced cooperation



# **Provisional Application of the UPC**

Protocol on Provisional Application requires consent of 13 Member States:

- 8 Member States so far:
   DK, FI, FR, IT, LU, NL, SE, UK
- 3 Member States due by May (BE, MT, DE)
- 2 additional Member States still required

Target date: <u>end of May</u>, to allow for an orderly entry into operation of the Court



#### **Three Commission actions:**

- 1. Clarifying how the unitary patent will fit together with EU law on supplementary protection certificates and national patents
- 2. Developing close partnership with the EPO in the context of unitary patent protection



#### **Commission actions cont.:**

- **3.** Implementing our Nov. 2016 Strategy "Putting IP at the service of SMEs to foster innovation and growth"
  - Clear evidence on importance of IPRs to support growth and employment: SMEs that own IP rights have over 30% higher revenue per employee than firms that do not
  - But under-use by SMEs: only 9% of SMEs own IPRs and 0.3% of SMEs own EU patents



# Measures in IP for SMEs package

- (i) helping IP awareness of SMEs
- (ii) pre-diagnostic services
- (iii) co-funding SMEs in obtaining EU patents
- (iv) Online platform for patent licensing
- (v) EU IP mediation/arbitration network
- (vi) EU-level insurance schemes for IP litigation
- (vii) coordination of IP support funding schemes
