It oversees the implementation of key EU chemicals regulations, namely on registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemicals (REACH), classification, labelling and packaging (CLP), biocidal products and prior informed consent for the export and import of hazardous chemicals (PIC), for the benefit of human health and the environment while supporting innovation and competitiveness).
