Dear Prime Minister,

Thank you for accepting our invitation to meet with a delegation of Members from our respective Committees on Friday 1 December from 10:00 at your premises.

As you are aware, the delegation is following a decision by the Conference of Presidents of the European Parliament to send a fact-finding mission to Malta with Members from the Committees on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs (LIBE) and the Committee of Inquiry into Money Laundering, Tax Avoidance and Tax Evasion (PANA), in the respective remit of the two Committees.

The objective of the mission is to meet the national authorities and the relevant stakeholders as a follow up of the resolution on the rule of law in Malta adopted by the Parliament on 15 November 2017.

As you are probably aware, we would also appreciate a meeting with your Chief of Staff, Mr Schembri, which could take place in the margins of your meeting with our Members.


