The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) was founded in 2007 and is based in Helsinki. It oversees the implementation of key EU chemicals regulations, namely on registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemicals (REACH), classification, labelling and packaging (CLP), biocidal products and prior informed consent for the export and import of hazardous chemicals (PIC), for the benefit of human health and the environment while supporting innovation and competitiveness).

The European Medicines Agency (EMA) was set up in 1995 and is based in London. It is responsible for the scientific evaluation and supervision of new medicines for human and veterinary use. It does this by bringing together expertise from national medicines agencies, hospitals and academia. Patients and healthcare professionals are also increasingly involved in the agency's work.
