UCC Work Programme : an ambitious programme

Completed :

- .eBTI
- .REX
- .EORI 2
- .Custom Decision
(Hybrid solution)



2 major updates of national IT systems :

- .Arrival/Presentation of goods (project 13)
- .Importation (project 14)

=> Mains concerns : allow sufficient **time for development, tests and training + possible changes of schedule**



Challenges :

- **Unsteady legal basis : Annexes A and B of DA/IA**

=> Additional workload and costs + legal uncertainty

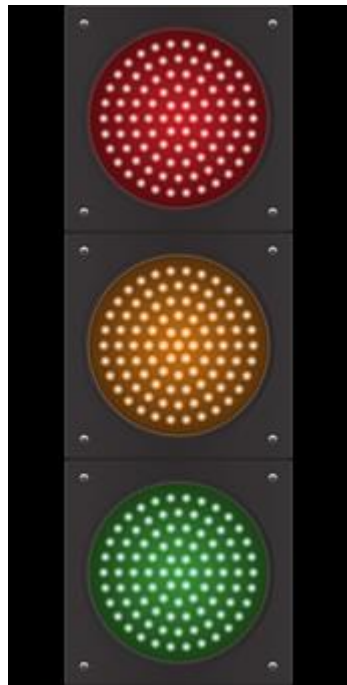
- **Impact of other EU projects (out of the UCC WP)**
