Recital Q should read as follows:

Q. whereas the victims of terrorism are a reference for democracy and whereas the public authorities should heed their voice and ensure that they are taken into account in the places where decisions are made to combat those who have made them unwilling protagonists,

Paragraph 1(a), subparagraph 3 should read as follows:

the unit will encourage the organisation of a European Forum for the Victims of Terrorism, to be attended by representatives of the EU institutions, the Council of Europe and the Member States' parliaments and governments, and also by representatives of associations and foundations for victims of terrorism;

(Concerns all languages)

Paragraph 1(l) should read as follows:

- (l) develop educational programmes with the media with a view to:
- condemning all forms of violence, especially terrorism;
 - combating environments which foster and are a breeding ground for racial, religious or ideological hatred;
