Recital M

- M. whereas, following the 'no' votes in the referendums on the Treaty establishing a Constitution for Europe in France and the Netherlands (*deletion*), an important signal could be given by resuming the debate on the future of the Union, *beginning with an acknowledgement of the people's rejection of any Super State and any kind of supranational integration, and with an acceptance of the fact that there is no possibility of substituting or superimposing (either by legal means or by the force of arms) a new political community or a new area of citizenship to replace the thirty or so peoples who inhabit our continent, or of constructing a living democracy beyond the bounds of sovereign nations,*
