Amendment 47 to read as follows:

Amendment 47 Article 20, paragraph 2

For the purposes of this Article, assistance on board shall be assistance *offered* to a person with reduced mobility in order to allow this person to have access to the same services in the train as other *passengers should* the extent of the person's reduced mobility not allow him or her to have access to those services independently and in safety. For the purposes of this Article, assistance on board shall be *all reasonable efforts to offer* assistance to a person with reduced mobility in order to allow this person to have access to the same services in the train as other *passengers. Should* the extent of the person's reduced mobility not allow him or her to have access to those services independently and in safety, *he or she shall be accompanied by another person, who shall travel free of charge. When there is no accompanying staff on board the train, railway undertakings may provide for alternative facilities or arrangements, in order to achieve the same purpose.*
