European Parliament resolution on the EU strategy on Roma inclusion

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 157(4) of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the European Union as a whole, and certain Member States in particular, face economic, social, demographic and territorial uncertainties as a result of the current situation in the countries of North Africa,
- B. whereas it is not necessary to take European-level action on the issue of the integration of the Roma as set out in its report on the EU strategy on Roma inclusion, thereby not prejudicing the sovereign principle of subsidiarity applicable to each Member State,
- 1. Rejects the report on the EU strategy on Roma inclusion, believing that it is not appropriate at present to reinforce a strategy aimed solely and exclusively at the Roma but that, on the contrary, an effective and urgent strategy is required to address the issue of legal and illegal immigration in general, in order to guarantee economic stability, employment, security, public order and justice first and foremost for European citizens who already form part of a Member State demographically, culturally, by tradition, historically and economically;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the Commission and the governments and parliaments of the Member States.
