**Article 4 – paragraph 4 a (new)**

*Text proposed by the Commission*

*Amendment*

***4a. In order to promote the prevention of waste, Member States shall encourage, in particular:***

***(a) ship owners, in liaison with ship builders, material and equipment manufacturers, to limit the use of hazardous materials in ships and to reduce them as far as possible from the conception of the ships onwards, so as, in particular, to prevent their release of such substances into the environment, facilitate ship recycling, and avoid the need to dispose of hazardous waste;***

***(b) the design and production of new ships which take into full account and facilitate the dismantling, the repair and, in particular, the recycling of end-of life ships and ship components and materials;***

***(c) ship builders, in liaison with material and equipment manufacturers, to integrate an increasing quantity of recycled material in ships and other products, in order to develop the markets for recycled materials.***
