Amendment 1

Parliament's Rules of Procedure Rule 166

Present text

When voting on any proposal for a legislative act, whether by way of a single and/or final vote, Parliament shall vote by roll call using the electronic voting system.

Amendment 2

Parliament's Rules of Procedure Rule 195 – paragraph 3

Present text

3. Voting in committee shall be by show of hands, *unless* a quarter of the committee's members *request a vote by roll call. In this case the vote shall be taken in accordance with Rule 167(2)*.

Amendment

When *deciding* on *the basis of a report*, *Parliament shall take any* single and/or final vote by roll call *in accordance with Rule 167(2)*.

Amendment

3. Voting in committee shall be by show of hands. However, the vote shall be taken by roll call in accordance with Rule 167(2) in the case of a single and/or final vote on a report or if so requested by a quarter of the committee's members.
