*39a. Considers that the use of hydraulic fracturing in the Union entails risks and negative consequences for the climate, the environment and public health, and threatens the achievement of the EU's long-term decarbonisation goal; considers, furthermore, that on account of the limited potential of unconventional fuels to help meet the EU's future energy demand, coupled with high investment and exploitation costs, hydraulic fracturing is not a promising technology; urges the Member States, therefore, not to authorise any new operations involving the exploration or extraction of unconventional fuels within the EU until this is proven to be safe for the environment, citizens and workers;*
