53a. Points out that many Member States do not have specific laws against organised crime, although its involvement in cross-border activities and sectors affecting the EU's financial interests, such as smuggling or counterfeiting of currency, is constantly growing; considers it essential that Member States adopt the measures set out in resolutions on combating organised crime^{1a};
