Justification

Given the introduction of a new category of "medium water suppliers" in AM 43, it is important to make consequential changes here, otherwise it would be unclear how often medium water suppliers should update online information about the monitoring results of chemical parameters. Given the change in the definitions, "medium water suppliers" as referred to by ENVI are equivalent to "large water suppliers" as defined by the Commission. Medium water suppliers should therefore have the same updating frequency as large water suppliers.

Justification

Given the introduction of a new category of "very small water suppliers" via AM 41, they need to be referred to explicitly here so as to ensure that they also provide online information about the most recent monitoring results for chemical parameters. As for small water suppliers, the minimum updating frequency of one year should apply.
