Parliament's Rules of Procedure**Rule 11 – paragraph 3 – subparagraph 2***Present text*

In parliamentary debates, Members shall not resort to ***defamatory, racist or xenophobic language or behaviour, nor shall they unfurl banners.***

Amendment

In parliamentary debates ***in plenary***, Members shall not resort to ***offensive language, particularly language which could be considered to be a form of discrimination, or an attack, based on sex, racial or ethnic origin, religion or belief, disability, age or sexual orientation, against the principle laid down in Article 10 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.***
