European Parliament recommendation to the Council on developing a strategic concept on tackling organised crime

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the communication from the Commission to the Council and the European Parliament on developing a strategic concept on tackling organised crime,
- having regard to Rule 114(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas there is a need to develop a strategic concept on tackling organised crime at EU level with Union bodies such as Europol, Eurojust, CEPOL and the Police Chiefs,
- B. whereas various legislative and non-legislative initiatives contributing to the prevention of and fight against organised crime have been adopted at EU level since the creation of an area of freedom, security and justice,
- 1. Addresses the following recommendations to the Council:
 - (a) that the relevant legal instruments regarding Europol and Eurojust be ratified and implemented to strengthen the fight against organised crime;
 - (b) that a comprehensive and coherent framework be established for law enforcement cooperation against organised crime;
 - (c) that legislation be approximated to complement the mutual recognition of judicial decisions in criminal matters;
 - (d) that support be provided for the development of multilateral approaches to combat organised crime;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this recommendation to the Council and, for information, to the Commission and the European Council.
