**Paragraph 1**

*Motion for a resolution*

1. Declares that water is a shared resource of humankind and, therefore, should not be a source of profit and that access to water should constitute a fundamental and universal right; welcomes the recognition by the United Nations of the human right to safe drinking water and sanitation, as derived from the right to an adequate standard of living; calls for all necessary efforts to be made to guarantee access to water to the most deprived populations by 2015;

*Amendment*

1. Declares that water is a shared resource of humankind and, therefore, should not be a source of *illegitimate* profit and that access to water should constitute a fundamental and universal right; welcomes the recognition by the United Nations of the human right to safe drinking water and sanitation, as derived from the right to an adequate standard of living; calls for all necessary efforts to be made to guarantee access to water to the most deprived populations by 2015;
