Motion for a European Parliament resolution on European measures to combat organised crime, terrorism and other serious transnational crimes

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 83 TFEU,
 - having regard to the European Parliament resolution of 23 October 2013 on organised crime, corruption and money laundering: recommendations on action and initiatives to be taken¹,
 - having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas criminal organisations have broadened their area of activity internationally, by diversifying and developing their illegal transnational activities, also in relation to terrorism;
1. Calls on the Council to update the areas of crime referred to in Article 83 TFEU with regard, in particular, to money laundering in all its forms, trafficking in human beings, facilitation of illegal immigration and the activities of so-called foreign fighters;
 2. Calls on the Commission to submit legislative proposals to establish a set of common minimum rules concerning:
 - a. organised crime, especially mafia-style crime;
 - b. counterfeiting, piracy and computer crime;
 - c. money laundering;
 - d. so-called emerging crimes, as mentioned in paragraph 125 of the above-mentioned resolution of 23 October 2013;
 - e. foreign fighters.
