Motion for a European Parliament resolution on protecting workers' acquired rights

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas Article 24 of Legislative Decree No 201 of 6 December 2011, as taken over and amended in Article 1(1) of Law No 214 of 22 December 2011, altered the legal relationship between workers in need and the social security agencies in their capacity as government bodies responsible for administering compulsory public pension schemes, in clear breach of the fundamental rights of millions of Italian workers and pensioners;
- B. whereas the Italian Constitutional Court recently declared inadmissible an application for a referendum on repealing Article 24, on the basis of a tendentious reading of the Italian Constitution;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to take steps to protect the above rights, which have been violated by this wrong decision handed down by the Italian Constitutional Court and are enshrined in the constitutional traditions of the Member States, as well as in the Charter of Fundamental Rights and the Treaties.
