Motion for a European Parliament resolution on cybersecurity

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the proposal for a directive on network and information security (NIS)¹,
 - having regard to the EU strategy for cybersecurity²,
 - having regard to the NIS public-private platform³,
 - having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
 - A. whereas a European Cyber Security Month has been established⁴;
 - B. whereas the above tools help to improve the security of the Surface Web or Clearnet and improve the synergy of public-private actions so as to provide a more effective response to cyber attacks;
 - C. whereas, however, there are still delays in the development of measures against cybercrime in the Clearnet, which represents only a small part of the overall web, while the response to the invisible web is still very limited, even though the latter is much more extensive than the former and includes both the Darknet (p2p file sharing) and the deep web (not indexed), where drug trafficking, terrorism, pornography, counterfeiting and arms trafficking take place, with transactions being made in Bitcoin that are difficult to trace;
1. Calls on the Council and the Commission to strengthen the EU's response capability to this global threat, to strengthen network and information security and to support Member States in their research and innovation aimed at promoting public and private digital security, including security relating to the development of Internet of Things - IoT.
