Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the unemployment crisis: pressing need for suitable action

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, according to a study recently published by the *Openpolis* Association, unemployment in Italy rose by 108.2 % between 2007 and 2014;
- B. whereas the study indicated that the average increase for Europe was 41.67%, rising from 7.2 % in 2007 to 10.2 % in 2014;
- 1. Considers that, given its expertise in the field of social policy and employment, the Commission should take immediate, urgent and appropriate action to bring unemployment levels down and keep them within acceptable limits.
