Motion for a European Parliament resolution on re-establishing democracy in Europe

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 1(2) of the Charter of the United Nations,
- having regard to Article 50 of the Treaty on European Union,
- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas democracy is, by definition, rule by the people, and the absence of a European people means that any supranational institution in Europe is undemocratic;
- B. whereas the European Union has become incapable of convincing the peoples within it of its supposed benefits and can no longer implement its will except by force or by trickery;
- C. whereas it is pointless to adopt resolutions about violations of human rights, democracy and the rule of law in places all over the world if we cannot start by applying those principles to ourselves;
- 1. Believes that the European Union has become a technocratic monster preventing the peoples within it from exercising their right of self-determination;
- 2. Asks the Commission to draw up a decision dissolving the European Union, to be submitted for approval by the sovereign peoples of the Member States;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council and the Member States.
