Motion for a European Parliament resolution on Commission measures to sustain EU exports affected by Russian embargo and the crisis in China

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, according to an official report by the SACE Chief Economist recently published by a well-known Italian newspaper, the devaluation of the yuan and the stock market collapse in China could be detrimental to the Italian export market, which is already having to cope with the embargo imposed by Russia in retaliation for EU sanctions;
- B. whereas this is affecting not only Italy but the entire EU economy;
- 1. Calls on the European Commission to take action to relaunch the economy, measures to sustain exports being indispensable in this connection.
