Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the need to set up identification and registration centres in North Africa

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the migration crisis shows no sign of diminishing and, on the contrary, is likely to increase and to last over time, as recently admitted by the director of Frontex and by the UNHCR;
- B. whereas the recent Commission proposal to set up identification and registration centres ('hotspots') in Italy and Greece cannot be deemed to be an acceptable solution;
- 1. Calls on the Commission and the Council to liaise with the countries of North Africa that are considered to be stable, with a view to setting up centres to identify, rescue and register migrants and refugees in those countries.
