Motion for a European Parliament resolution on EU immigration policy, which 89 % of Italians consider a failure

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas a recent IPSOS poll, commissioned by the Institute for International Political Studies (ISPI) and the news channel RaiNews24, on the influx of migrants and how it has been managed by certain European governments has revealed that a worrying 89 % of Italians believe that EU immigration policy is a failure;
- 1. Calls on the Commission and its Vice-President/High Representative for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy to take note of this important statistic and to change their own approach accordingly, giving up the disastrous attempt to take in immigrants at all costs and instead taking the more sensible option of providing assistance in their home countries.
