Motion for a European Parliament resolution on devices to manipulate computer systems that control harmful emissions from motor vehicles

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the Volkswagen scandal uncovered in the United States, concerning the issue of rigged statistics for the levels of environmental pollution generated by diesel cars, has drawn attention to the need for rules concerning these so-called 'defeat devices';
- B. whereas the German federal government itself recently stressed the need for an EU legal framework seeking to reduce the real emissions of motor vehicles, taking into account also any possible manipulation;
- 1. Calls on the Commission seriously and scrupulously to look into the entire matter as it has come to light in the United States and to draft some effective and incisive legislation that takes into consideration also any fraudulent behaviour such as that which has emerged in the Volkswagen affair.
