Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the unfair nature of the decision adopted by the Justice and Home Affairs Council in its meeting of 22 September 2015 concerning distribution of asylum-seeker quotas

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas in its meeting of 22 September 2015 the Justice and Home Affairs Council adopted the decision to relocate 120 000 asylum seekers, only 15 600 of them from Italy, in various Member States;
- B. whereas Italy is the country which has always contributed most to the rescue and assistance of refugees;
- C. whereas it should be stressed that 15 600 people land in Italy approximately every three days;
- 1. Condemns the decision by the Justice and Home Affairs Council as unjust, unfair and illegitimate, as completely discriminatory against Italy and as contrary to the Treaties, and calls for it to be revised on the basis of figures which should be at least 10 times higher.
