Motion for a European Parliament resolution on dogfighting in the European Union

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas Regulation (EC) No 998/2003 governs the movement of dogs and other pet animals in the European Union;
- B. whereas dogfighting is a barbaric practice which still takes place in the EU and which encourages trafficking;
- C. whereas this practice is at odds with European approaches to animal welfare;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to take further action to put an end to dogfighting once and for all throughout the EU;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council and the Member States.
