Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the bombing of the Médecins sans Frontières hospital in Kunduz

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, during the night of 3 October 2015, the traumatology centre run by Médecins sans Frontières in Kunduz, Afghanistan, was bombed several times by NATO forces, following a decision taken by the USA, leaving many patients and members of the medical and paramedical staff dead or injured and causing serious structural damage to the building, whose location was well known to the forces engaged in fighting in the area;
- 1. Condemns this serious war crime, extends its condolences to the families of the persons killed, expresses its solidarity with the wounded and with Médecins sans Frontières staff, all of whom are victims of this glaring breach of the Geneva Convention, and calls for those responsible to be identified and punished.
