Motion for a European Parliament resolution on a repatriation plan for migrants who do not have the right to remain in the ${\rm EU}$

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas at their recent meeting in Luxembourg EU home affairs ministers stressed that it was pointless to redistribute refugees without first knowing exactly how to send back those who did not have the right to remain in the EU;
- B. whereas the current approach is not working and an efficient, centralised repatriation system needs to be established;
- 1. Calls on the Commission and the Council to look into this issue and to come up with a swift and firm response that includes informing the countries of origin that any refusal to cooperate could result in their development aid being reduced, if not withheld altogether.
