Motion for a European Parliament resolution on measures to promote EU exports

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas EU exports are suffering as a result of the downturn in the world economy and strategic errors, such as the slowdown in the Chinese economy, the collapse in crude oil prices and the subsequent tightening of purse strings by the countries of the Middle East and the modest growth in the US economy, not to mention the crazy sanctions imposed by Russia or senseless trade agreements such as the one concluded with Vietnam;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to frame urgently-needed economic and regulatory measures to boost exports, as a major pillar of growth and development, which cannot be based on internal demand alone.
