# Motion for a European Parliament resolution on Italy's ranking (25th out of 28 countries) in the Social Justice Index

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 3 of the Treaty on European Union and Articles 9, 10, 19, 45-48, 145-150, and 151-164 TFEU,
- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas in the annual report of the Bertelsmann Foundation, better known as the Social Justice Index, which measures the degree of social injustice, Italy is ranked 25th out of the 28 EU Member States, and whereas young Europeans in general, and young Italians in particular, are the big losers in the economic and debt crisis that has beset Europe for years;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to implement the economic and social policies that have long been necessary and in that way help to overcome the crisis, in which young people are being hardest hit.
