Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the 2016 Commission work programme

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the second annual work programme that the Commission presented to Parliament in Strasbourg recently deserves to be rejected out of hand, as it does nothing to correct earlier mistakes and instead of breaking new ground rehashes measures that are doomed to fail before they even get off the ground, as is the case with the quotabased refugee redistribution plan;
- 1. Calls accordingly on the Commission to draw the appropriate conclusions from what has been a long line of errors in the handling of sensitive matters such as the LuxLeaks and Volkswagen scandals, the EU-Vietnam agreement, the sanctions against Russia, the Syrian conflict and the situation in Libya, and, of course, growth and development, which currently look like an impossible dream.
