Motion for a European Parliament resolution on combating Islamic terrorism

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, as the Council of EU Ministers for Education, Youth, Culture and Sport decided at its meeting yesterday, the fight against terrorism starts in the classroom;
- B. whereas, according to Commissioner Tibor Navracsics, Erasmus + will enable us to defeat radicalisation: ‘we have already taken steps to ensure that in 2016 funding priority will be given to projects dealing with integration and the fight against radicalisation’;
- C. whereas the Italian Minister for Education, Stefania Giannini, has said that ‘we need to offer a future to everyone who is socially disadvantaged, not only the children of migrant communities, but also European children who are denied access to education’;
- D. whereas the ideas which emerged from yesterday's Council meeting must be rejected as completely inappropriate, demagogical and dangerous;
- E. whereas it should be pointed out once again that terrorist organisations are born and are developed with the aim of overturning by means of violence the economic and social order constituted by the State, and are certainly not clubs for social misfits;
- 1. Calls on all the EU institutions to abide by the guidelines issued at the special Council meeting on the fight against terrorism held on 20 November 2015 with a view to preventing further attacks and safeguarding the area of freedom, security and justice provided for by Article 3(2) of the Treaty on European Union.
