Motion for a European Parliament resolution on protecting EU citizens from increased antibiotic resistance resulting from the use of genetically modified feed

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the long term damage caused by the use of genetically modified feed to the food chain cannot be predicted and could therefore adversely affect the health of European citizens or for a long time detract from the possibilities of treating serious illnesses owing to the resulting increase in antibiotic resistance at each stage of the food chain;
- B. whereas the cultivation of genetically modified feed affects the entire ecosystem, including transmission to non-manipulated organisms;
- 1. Takes the view that, in the light of the above-mentioned risks to public health, the cultivation and import into the EU of all genetically modified feed must be prohibited.
