#### Motion for a European Parliament resolution on deaths at the workplace

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the Italian Institute for Insurance against Accidents at Work (INAIL) has reported that the number of work-related deaths is on the increase, something which runs counter to the trend recorded at the end of October which saw a decrease in the number of workplace accidents, when at the same time there were approximately 100 more work-related deaths than that same period in 2014;
- B. whereas the Italian Institute for Insurance against Accidents at Work (INAIL) believes that 'this is an alarming increase', inasmuch as there were 729 reports of fatal accidents in the first 10 months of 2015 (an increase of 16.1 %) which amount to 101 more victims than that same period the year before;
- 1. Calls on the European Commission, by virtue of its responsibilities in relation to health and safety in the workplace pursuant to Articles 91, 114, 115, 151, 153 and 352 TFEU, to implement appropriate policies to eradicate this miserable phenomenon which continues to plague far too many workers in Europe.
