Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the Commission's overstepping of its powers

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the Commission has recently submitted a proposal whereby it would have the power to send police forces into Member States to defend external borders in the face of unprecedented migration pressure;
- B. whereas this amounts to encroachment on the Member States' sovereignty on a hitherto unmatched scale;
- 1. Believes that the Commission has been constantly seeking over the past few years to assume powers to which it is not entitled;
- 2. Calls on the Commission, having regard to Article 17 TEU and Articles 234, 244-250, 290, and 291 TFEU, to refrain from exceeding its role under the Treaties.
