Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the UN proposal for Europe to take in 50 million migrants by 2050

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, under a ridiculous and frankly dangerous UN proposal, Europe will be asked to take in 50 million migrants in the first half of the 21st century;
- 1. Calls on the EU institutions to take real steps now to tackle the migration problem by launching humanitarian, diplomatic and military initiatives designed to stem the massive, uncontrolled influx of immigrants and by helping the countries of origin in question on the spot;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council, the Vice-President/High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy and the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
