Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the COP 21 recommendations adopted by the European Union

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the European Union has adopted the recommendations of COP 21 unreservedly and without giving any credit whatsoever to recognised experts who are unaffiliated with the IPCC and who do not attribute global warming exclusively to human activities;
- 1. Calls on the Commission, in view of its competences in the area of environmental policy (Article 11 and Articles 191 to 193 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union), to also take into account the work of independent researchers who are proposing innovative solutions in the area of renewable energy, while focusing, in particular, on the importance of nuclear energy and giving credibility to the fact that global warming is not exclusively attributable to human activities.
