Motion for a European Parliament resolution on compulsory removal and disposal of asbestos roofing and other asbestos-containing material from buildings

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas removing all asbestos from buildings is of key importance in protecting human health and the environment;
- B. whereas it is now illegal to use this dangerous material in roofing and other building materials;
- C. whereas the laws banning the use of asbestos also lay down specific rules governing its removal and disposal;
- D. whereas many of the buildings that still contain asbestos are located in built-up areas and therefore pose, at the very least, a potential risk to human health and the environment;
- E. whereas the current laws and rules in this area are far from satisfactory;
- 1. Believes that the rules governing the removal and disposal of all types of asbestoscontaining material need to be tightened up;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to submit a legislative proposal overhauling the current rules on asbestos, so that more uniform, effective action may be taken to protect the environment and human health and safety.
