Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the need for Turkey to clarify its position on the 'Islamic State' group

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas 10 German tourists were killed in the suicide attack in Istanbul on 12 January 2016;
- B. whereas that attack can only be seen as a consequence of Turkey's ambiguous relations with the various Islamist terrorist movements operating in Syria and carrying out attacks in many countries;
- 1. Calls on the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy to press the Turkish Government to clarify its position on the 'Islamic State' terrorist group.
